But good thing we didn't bet on the game!!!!

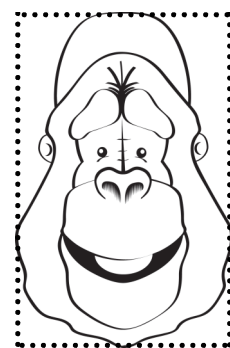
