**Congregational Meeting. Sunday Sept 8th on Rally Day.**

On Rally Day we kick off a lot of activities every year. And this year, in addition to our normal commencements, we plan to hold a short congregational meeting immediately after service. Please plan to attend and hear about our schedule of planned listening sessions. We will be conducting a Feasibility Study in which we are asking for feedback on the vision presented at the congregational meeting. In September, each household will receive a packet in the mail with a letter, survey and a draft vision statement (below) that details our vision for St Paul's UCC. If you do not receive a packet, you can pick one up in the church office. We will encourage each household to get involved in this process by completing and returning a survey. There will also be times to sign-up for interviews for those who would like to share their thoughts more in depth. Most importantly, please continue to pray for our church family as we journey through this process together.

**Attention – anyone who wants to make music!!**

The Choirs at St. Paul's are going to begin this year on **Wednesday, Sept. 4th** and we would love to have any and all with us to sing (or play hand chimes). These groups will meet on Wednesday evenings as follows:

- **Hand Chimes = 6:00 to 6:30 PM** in the Choir Room (any age – as long as you can hold and make sounds come from the chimes) No previous hand chime experience needed – we'll make you a pro in no time. We perform in church once a month. Mark Dundore will be directing again this year. Talk to him about your willingness to play!
- **Choristers = 6:30 to 7:00 PM** in the Choir Room (children in grades 1 thru 5) We hope that parents will continue to bring their children each week so that they can sing once a month at the late service. Jonne Dundore leads this group – please talk to her!
- **Youth Choir = 6:30 to 7:15 PM** in the Sanctuary (school grades 6 thru 12) This group and sings 2-3 times a month at early and late services. No singing skill required – we'll teach you how. We love having new members to fill out the ranks – there's safety in numbers! We need changed male voices right now!
- **Chancel Choir = 7:15 to 8:30 PM** in the Sanctuary (ages post high-school thru extreme maturity) The adult singing group usually sings around 3 times a month at either the early or late service. Previous experience is not required – just be able to enjoy yourself and others.

Please consider coming out and being a part of our Music Program here at St. Paul's. We need you and you will have a great time! We do understand schedules – and know you will come when you can and won't when you can't.
